





Rotating injection sites can help reduce the risk of developing lipohypertrophy<sup>1</sup>, which is a common complication of insulin injections that can cause lumps and bumps underneath the skin and can contribute to erratic insulin absorption and unexplained hypoglycemia.<sup>2</sup>
